

ISNITE 2026 Poster Presentation Guidelines

1. Dimensions and Orientation

- **Size:** The recommended poster size is **70 cm (width) x 100 cm (height)** (standard B1 size) or **A0** (84.1 x 118.9 cm).
- **Orientation:** All posters must be prepared in **Portrait (Vertical)** orientation to ensure fit on the provided exhibition boards.

2. Visual Layout and Design

- **Header:** The top of the poster should include the title of the paper, authors' names, and their institutional affiliations.
- **Readability:** Text should be legible from a distance of at least 1 meter. We suggest using a minimum font size of **24-30 pt** for the main body and **48-60 pt** for headings.
- **Content:** It is recommended to include sections such as Introduction, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, and Key References. The use of charts, graphs, and images is highly encouraged to enhance visual communication.

3. Printing and Mounting

- **Printing:** Participants are responsible for printing their own posters and bringing them to the conference venue.
- **Mounting:** Materials for attaching the posters to the boards (e.g., double-sided tape, pins) will be provided by the organizing committee at the registration desk.

4. Presentation

- Authors are expected to stand by their posters during the designated **Poster Sessions** to discuss their research and answer questions from fellow participants.
